PRESENTATION DESIGN

Clients call on us for help with their presentations. Sometimes all they need are custom-designed templates for title and secondary slides, but more often they want us to “fix it” – lay out all the slides, providing enhancements, graphics and charts.

The key to a dynamic presentation is minimalism. Resist the impulse to cram every bit of data – plus a complete narrative – into slide after slide. Get really comfortable with your content. Make notes. Memorize your message so you can easily talk about the details, while letting your slides show only the most important concepts.

For visual relief and readability, we add white space. We search for illustrations or photographs that are superior to the PowerPoint image library. PowerPoint’s special effects tools are powerful, but usually it takes a designer’s eye to know how to use them to enhance rather than distract. Few clients are eager to design their slides; naturally, it’s not their forte. That’s what we’re here for!
